CLOTHING:

Casual clothes entire weekend. Be prepared for chilly evenings.

SPORTS EQUIPMENT AND OTHER STUFF:

DRIVING DIRECTIONS:

For comfort, allow 5-6 hours from Beaufort.

- Take 1-95 North to I-26.
- Follow I-26 West to Hendersonville, N.C.
- Take exit 49-B on US 64 West into Hendersonville. Continue for 2.3 miles.
- Turn left on South Business 25 South (Church Street) and drive 9 blocks.
- Turn right on Kanuga Street and go 3.75 miles to Kanuga Lake Road.
- Turn right on Kanuga Lake Road and drive 1.25 miles (past Camp Kanuga on the right).
- Turn right on Kanuga Chapel Drive. (Neil Park Entrance is on your right.)
- Turn left into the first big paved parking lot (the Chapel of Transfiguration is on the right).
- The lobby entrance is to the left of the Kanuga Bookstore.

He is married to Louise Hack, and they are the parents of two children, Catherine, an attorney in St. Louis, and Edward III of Houston, Texas, and as of September, the grandfather of Fiona Salmon.
